Thank you for joining the fight against breast cancer by organizing a team for the Komen SC Mountains to Midlands Race for the Cure® on Saturday, September 24, 2011 at Fluor Field. This year we celebrate the 17th Anniversary of the Race for the Cure® in the Mountains to Midlands! As a Team Captain, you are instrumental to the success of the Race. Whether you are forming your team for a large corporation or a handful of friends, your leadership and commitment will contribute towards achieving the mission of Susan G. Komen for the Cure®.

Last year, 230 teams helped raise over \$500,000 for breast cancer research, education, screening and treatment. Up to 75% of the net revenue raised from the Komen SC Mountains to Midlands Race for the Cure® stays in our 22 county service area for women that so desperately need our help. The remaining 25% goes to fund cuttingedge breast cancer research locally and nationwide.

This Team Captain Handbook was created to assist you in team recruitment and registration, as well as provide the required deadlines and forms. We want to make your role as Team Captain successful and rewarding for both you and your teammates. I am your Team Chair, your primary point of contact. Please don't hesitate to contact me for assistance in promoting the Race, recruiting teammates and meeting important deadlines, or with any other questions that may arise.

The first step is to register your team online at www.KomenSCMM.org. Once you set up your team online, you can send out emails inviting others to join your team, give updates on your team fundraising success and track team participation. Potential team members can link to the registration site from your email or register via www.KomenSCMM.org. Remember to tell your team members that they can register for Sleep In for the Cure®/ Tailgate for the Cure and be counted in your team totals even if they can't attend the Race, but want to support the cause.

Last year 95% of team participants registered online with our easy to use Race registration software! By having your team register online, you don't have to collect registration forms and checks! Also, participants get a substantial discount by registering online, receive an e-tax receipt for all donations and can register multiple people by entering their credit card or debit card just once!

Thank you again for your dedication, compassion and commitment in the battle against breast cancer. With your continued efforts, one day we will find a cure for a disease that has affected the lives of so many.

Why Support the Komen SC Mountains to Midlands Race for the Cure®?

What does Susan G. Komen support with the monies raised through the Race for the Cure®?

75% of net proceeds remain in the SC Mountains to Midlands community to fund local breast cancer education, screening and treatment. Since 1995, the SC Mountains to Midlands Affiliate of Susan G. Komen for the Cure® has invested \$3.6 million in the Mountains to Midlands!

How to Form a Team

1. Setting Up A Team

Team Captains must set-up their team online at www.KomenSCMM.org by clicking on *Komen Race for the Cure* and then select *Register*, and then *Start a Race Team*. By creating a team, you will automatically be assigned the role of Team Captain. If you registered last year you must utilize your Username and Password from last year to expedite the registration process. If you've forgotten your Username and/or Password, click on the "Lost Your Password" link located below the Login button on our Event Home Page.

PLEASE NOTE: When creating a team, you must use a letter as the first character in the name.

2. Registering Team Members

Once the team is setup online, team members can register two ways:

- Online: Once you set up your team online, you can send out emails inviting others to join your team. Potential team members can link to the registration site from the email you send or register via our website: www.KomenSCMM.org by using a credit or debit card.
- By mailing in their paper registration forms to the Komen office, 301 Halton Road, Suite D2, Greenville SC 29607

3. Team Reports

Team Captains can download a Team Report via a menu link from the Team Options tab. This report contains basic team member information as well as individual and team fundraising totals. This report lists team member T-shirt sizes if you plan to create a team T-shirt. To view this report, go to your Participant Center and scroll down. On the right hand side of the screen you will see a link to "View Team Member Report."

4. Pick Up T-Shirts and Bibs:

Team Captains can receive all of their team's T-shirts and bibs during Team Packet Pick Up, September 23, between the hours of 11 am and 7 pm at Fluor Field, 945 South Main Street in Greenville. We will offer additional pick up dates this year. Please check our website for additional information.

All Sleep In for the Cure® participants and participants who opted to have their packet mailed to them will have their T-shirt and bib mailed to them.



Online Registration

Register Online – The Easiest and Best Method!

Over 95% of team participants registered online last year. Online registration has never been easier and offers important benefits:

- Lower registration fees
- E-tax receipts are provided for all donations
- You can register multiple people by entering your credit card or debit card just once!

Team Page:

Once you register your team online, you will automatically have a Team Page and can send emails to recruit individuals to join your team. You can customize your team page by personalizing your message and by uploading photos. Prospective team members can register by clicking on the link automatically sent with your email or they can visit our website: www.KomenSCMM.org and click on the Race Registration link and follow the prompts to register as a team member.

Personal Fundraising Page:

In addition to your Team Page, you will also automatically have a Personal Fundraising Page to ask your family, friends and coworkers to donate if they can't join your team. You can customize your Personal Fundraising Page by personalizing your message and by uploading photos. All personal fundraising totals are included in the Team Fundraising totals.

The Online Deadline for Team Registration is September 22, 2011 at 10:00 pm

Offline Registration

1. Setting up a Team

Even if all members register off line, the Team Captain Must Set Up the Team Online at www.KomenSCMM.org and register as a team member.

2. Registering Team Members

Team Captain distributes Race registration forms to all prospective team members who decide not to register online and agree to pay the higher offline registration fee. Prior to distribution, we strongly recommend that Team Captains precomplete entry forms with your Team Name and Captain's Name in the specified area.

4. Mailing Deadline for Team Paper Registration Forms and Payments

The Team Captain must be sure that all completed registration forms and fees are postmarked by Friday, September 16 to the Komen Office. Team Captains must ensure that all forms are correct and complete. Entry forms that are not complete and not signed will not be processed.



Benefits of the Online Registration System

Add Pictures and Video to Individual & Team Fundraising Page: You can upload photos and video to your personal and team web pages, allowing a more personalized message to potential supporters.

Import your existing email address books: Quickly and easily upload your e-mail address book to your personal page. Your information is secure (only you can see the names that you have uploaded).

Team Messages: As the team captain, you can post messages to your team members using your personal page. Only team members will see these messages when they log in to their personal pages. Keep everyone up to date with the latest news!

Team Page – Team Member listing: A team member listing will appear on each Team Page. This listing contains a link to each member's Personal Fundraising Page. This feature allows for potential team members to view who has already joined a specific team prior to joining themselves.

Team Reports: Team Captains will be able to print off a complete team report of all their team members, including T-shirt sizes via the Team Report link on the right hand side of your participant center home page.

Need to Change Your Team Name? Once you set up your team, Captains can later change the team name and description. Email Teams@KomenSCMM.org for assistance.

Fundraising by Team Members: All Team Members can now fundraise online even if they registered via paper registration as long as they provided their email address.

Stay Up to Date: By using the online participant tools, you'll be up to date on all of your team happenings--who joined, who is fundraising, and how many days you have to go!

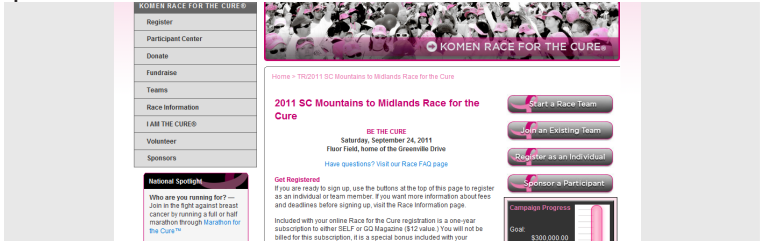

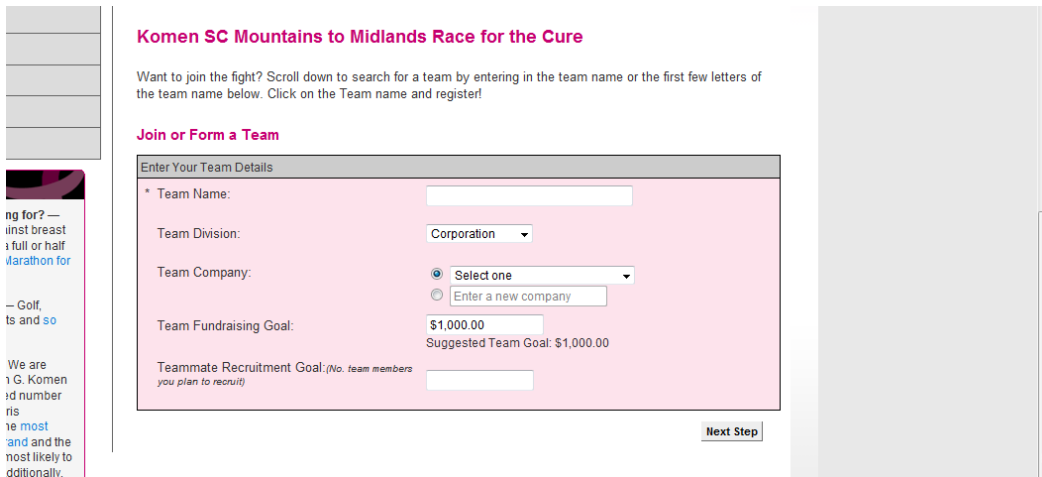
How to Use Your Participant Center to Support Your Team

Team Awards

All teams are categorized according to the team category: corporation, school, healthcare organization, and family/friends. Team awards will be given for:

- Pretty in Pink - most Survivors on Team (overall)
- Best Team T-shirt (overall)
- Largest Team
- Most Money Raised by a Team
- Most Sleep In for the Cure team members

Except for the “Most Money Raised by a Team,” the winners will be recognized during the Race Day ceremonies and will be listed in a press release after the Race. Teams have until Friday, October 31, 2011 to submit their team donations. The “Most Money Raised by a Team” will be announced in December 2011.

Teams who would like to enter their T-shirt for the Best Team T-shirt award must submit a clear digital photo of their T-shirt by email to stephanie@komenscmm.org by Thursday, September 15 at 5 pm. Online voting will begin on Monday, September 19 and will end on Thursday, September 22 at noon. Winners will be announced at the Race.

Friends for the Cure® pledge program rules:

- The program ends October 31, 2011. All donations must be received or postmarked by October 31, 2011 to be eligible for prizes.
- Fundraisers receive prizes based on their fundraising level as of October 31, 2011. Prizes do not accumulate as fundraisers move up levels.
- Pledges can be made three ways:
 - *Online* - Pledges can be made by going through the fundraiser's Personal Fundraising webpage or by going to www.KomenSCMM.org, click on Race for the Cure® Register/Login and search for your fundraiser's name. No pledge form needed, but donation MUST be put in fundraiser's name.
 - *In person* - Pledges, with pledge form, can be dropped off at the SC Mountains to Midlands Affiliate office or at Fluor Field on September 23-24.
 - *By mail* - Pledges, with pledge form, can be mailed to SC Mountains to Midlands Affiliate, Susan G. Komen for the Cure®, 301 Halton Rd, Greenville, SC 29607.
- Pledge money mailed or submitted by person, MUST be accompanied by an accurate and completed pledge form. Pledges submitted without a completed pledge form will NOT be counted towards prizes.
- Individual registration fee does not count toward fundraising total.
- Please make all checks payable to "Komen SC Mountains to Midlands Race for the Cure®."
- Tax Receipts are ONLY distributed via email. Donors who require a receipt must include an email address.
- Prizes will be ready for pick-up at the Komen Office on December 1, 2011. All unclaimed prizes will be mailed by December 31, 2011.
- Fundraisers receive prizes based on their fundraising level as of October 31, 2011. Prizes do not accumulate as fundraisers move up levels.



Fundraising Ideas for Teams

“Serve Your Sweet Tooth” Days

Everyone loves homemade desserts and everyone likes to make them! Have a contest to judge the best chocolate chip cookie. Have your CEO be the judge! Then sell all the entries to benefit your Race team!

Example: If you had a bake sale once a month for a year you could raise about \$1,000!

Casual Days

Ask your team members and other department representatives to collect a \$5 fee from employees who would like to dress down on Fridays. The donations will benefit – your Komen Race for the Cure Team!

Example: If you held a Casual Day once a month for a year and 100 employees participated, you would raise \$6,000!

“Water Cooler” Days

Have employees gather around the water cooler to take a break and buy bagels, pizza slices or popcorn on certain days of the week. Or have a team member take up collections for coffee and then do a delivery run. You can charge a little extra since you are bringing it to them.

Additional Tips

Brainstorm with your team. Be creative and think of things that can involve the entire company. Advertise your participation as much as possible and JUST ASK PEOPLE! Too often people just don't know how to get involved. A poster on a bulletin board may not get noticed, so make sure your event information stands out. The more excitement you can create, the more people will want to be a part of it! If you are having fun, your co-workers will too!

More Ideas

- Organize concession stands at games and festivals
- Challenge other departments within your organization to see which one raises the most money or has the most team members
- Sell “pink ribbon” decals for \$1 to write in the name of a loved one lost to or battling the disease and post on a wall at work. (Call the Affiliate office for the decals.)
- Auction off dinner for 4, sports or event tickets, gift certificates, etc.
- Organize a rummage sales/garage sales
- Sell your office services, such as cubicle cleaning, filing, helping out with a major mailing, etc.
- Hold contests/raffles
- Have your team be babysitters for a month and advertise through your company's e-mail
- Sell single flowers on Friday
- Sell company T-Shirts or sweatshirts
- Place donation jars around the office - “Every Penny Counts” Campaign
- Hold bake sales and/or pot luck lunches at work
- Find out if your company matches donations
- Create a goal board of thermometer showing the company's current fund raising status
- Create payroll stuffers to inform everyone about your team
- Raffle off a reserved parking spot or a larger office space
- Sell company “dress down” coupons at work



Fundraising Tips for Individuals

By participating in the Friends for the Cure® program as a fundraiser, you have an opportunity to make a difference in the fight to end breast cancer! Use the following fundraising tips and ideas to help you become a Passion Partner or even a Cure Leader!

1.	Show your commitment and contribute to yourself	\$25
2.	Ask your spouse/parent/family members to match your donation	\$75
3.	Ask your co-workers to donate (5 co-workers for \$5)	\$25
4.	Ask a vendor/supplier from your company	\$50
5.	Ask 5 friends to sponsor you for \$5 each	\$25
6.	Ask everyone in a club/organization (10 people for \$10)	\$100
7.	Send out a letter to your holiday card mailing list	\$100
8.	Ask businesses that you visit often for a donation	\$40
9.	Ask someone who has asked you for a donation	\$10
10.	Ask your boss for a company contribution	\$50

Total:		\$500

Here are some additional tips to help make collecting donations easier:

- Anyone is a potential donor.
- Ask people that you have daily contact with or who you've established a relationship with in one way or another parents, friends, classmates, co-workers, neighbors, grocer, banker, mechanic, lawyer, dry cleaner, fellow parishioners, etc.
- Start with the person whom you think will give you the largest donation, which will establish a high baseline of giving.
- Don't forget about matching gifts. Ask your company about matching gifts. Many companies will match whatever amount each employee raises on his or her own. Also, ask your supporters if their company will match their donation.
- Don't forget, you are not asking for money for yourself, it is for a great cause.
- Tell your pledge supporters why you're walking for Komen. When others know your motivation, they will be more likely to give.
- Collect your donations up front so you don't have to ask for them a second time.
- If you're uncomfortable asking face-to-face, use the website www.IAMTHECURE.org instead. On the Web we've provided sample letters to help you.
- Aim high — ask for \$50 and settle for \$25, instead of asking for \$25 and settling for \$10. Base the amount you're asking for on your prospects' ability to give.
- Carry your collection envelopes with you at all times.



Promotional Ideas

Building a Team

- When you register your team online, your Team Page and Personal Fundraising Page will automatically be set up for you. Email all your friends and family and encourage everyone to participate in your efforts so you can reach your fundraising goal! Once you create your home page, you can email the link to everyone in your address book encouraging folks to register on your team!
- Encourage those who will not be able to participate in the event to register for Sleep-In for the Cure®. These team members will still count towards your total and will also receive a Race Tshirt, special Snooze bib and commemorative gift in the mail.
- Encourage your team members to customize their own Personal Fundraising Page and then send out emails to family, colleagues and friends to raise money. Encourage them to make their own donation.

- Schedule Breast Health Education Events (call Affiliate office for breast health literature)
- Ask Clients and Vendors to Join
- Hold Breast Health Trivia Contests
- Organize Lunchtime Walks
- Create Attendance Prizes
- Create a Central Registration Table
- Announce at Company/Department Meetings
- Attach pink ribbons to offices, cubicles, doors or file cabinets for everyone who joins the team. Others will see the ribbons and want to get involved.
- Talk to Everyone You See
- Create a Thermometer Gauging Participation
- Join Training Programs
- Create a Message Board and Email Reminders Often
- Write article for organization's newsletter
